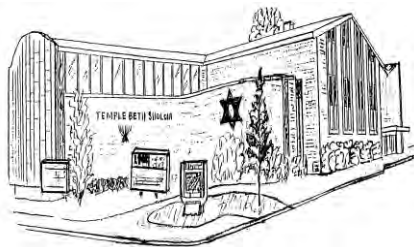

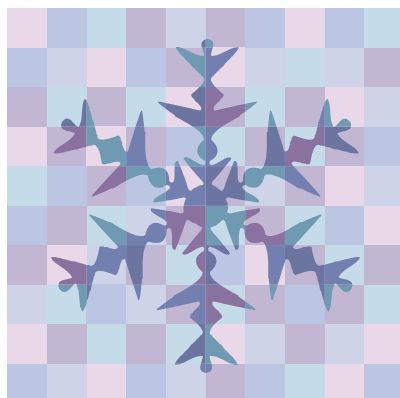

From the Rabbi's Desk

As I write this, Chanukah hasn't even begun yet! But I know that the glow of our *chanukiyot* will once again light up the darkest time of the year. As we enter into a new secular year, 2015 (I can't believe how time flies!) it may still be cold, but gradually the days will get longer and warmer. Sadly, it is still dark for many in our community. We hope for health, happiness and peace in the year to come, but some of us will inevitably experience sickness or the death of loved ones. Others may find that it is getting more difficult to get around as they age. Still others in our community are already home-bound.

We learn in the Mishnah (Avot 1:2): The world stands on three things: *Torah*, *Avodah* *v'G'milut Chasadim*—Torah (Study), Worship and Acts of Loving-Kindness. We all know that our synagogue has a wonderful Religious/Hebrew School and many opportunities for study whether it be our Adult Education programs, and weekly Torah study. Temple Beth

Sholom also affords us the opportunity to worship together as a community each and every Shabbat and holiday. But what about the opportunity for *g'milut chasadim*, acts of loving-kindness? Our world would not be complete if we didn't actively participate in the important *mitzvah* of doing *g'milut chasadim*, and many in our own community here at TBS will need your help. We are actively forming a **Caring Committee** and I urge everyone to volunteer to be on this committee. A Caring Committee sends notes and makes calls or visits to those who are ill; reaches out to those in the community who have a death in their family by either leading or attending shiva minyanim; providing company to those who may be home-bound; and we are seeing that many of our seniors who do not drive at night are finding it difficult to get to synagogue and need rides. I also need you to be my eyes and ears and if you know of anyone who is ill or in need, please let me know.

May we be blessed with opportunities for *mitzvot* and *g'milut chasadim* in 2015.

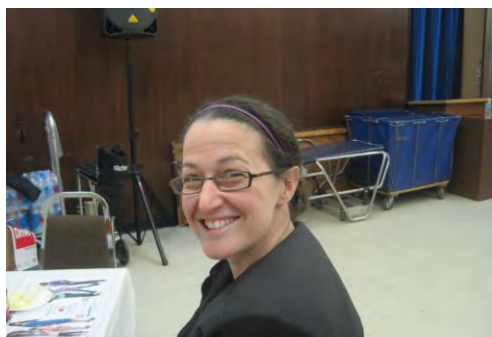

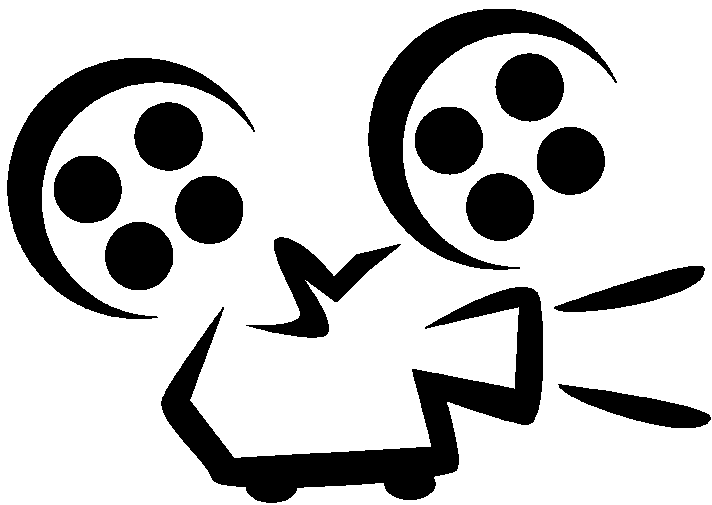

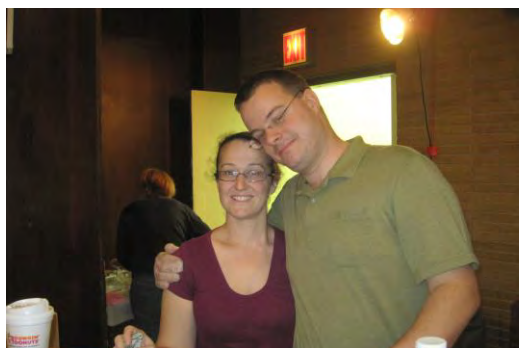

December Board of Trustees Meeting

The Board of Trustees met on Monday December 15, 2014. The Board approved new members Lisa and Diego Cano, and Financial Secretary Joyce Moss gave her Membership Report.. The Board approved the November financial report as presented by Charlene Metz, who also presented the 2015-2016 Budget as prepared by the Budget and Finance Committee. This budget will be presented to the Congregation at the January Congregational Meeting for review and vote. Vice President Joy Bobrow reported on Bazaar, and thanked the many volunteers who came out to work to make it successful. Sisterhood presented \$3,000.00 donation to Temple. Membership and Ways & Means Committees may merge, as they have been working together on several initiatives. The Purim Ball is still on for February 28th, but will not be combining with the ADL. Instead there will be a collection of food. The need for a Caring Committee was brought up, and it was recommended that we seek a volunteer to be the point person to contact if any Temple member is interested in participating in a group who would respond to Temple members in need. The Rabbi Contract Committee reported, and the Board voted to recommend offering a 2 year contract to Rabbi Ballan, with the same terms and conditions as her current contract, subject to approval by vote at the January Congregational Meeting.

Shalom, Shalom!

As I write this article, it is still Chanukah. When we light the candles, we follow the practice of Rabbi Hillel, and increase the light every night. As Jews, we always try to increase. We go up to Israel as we descend to Egypt. We make Aliyah, if we emigrate to Israel. Aliyah means a going up - an increase. In the Torah, we are reading about Joseph. Even his name means the one who is added. The Israelites increased greatly in Egypt. When we read about the leaving of Egypt and the crossing of the sea at the end of this month, the wealth of the Israelites is greatly increased, as they leave with silver and gold.

This month marks the birthday of Martin Luther King Jr. on January 15th. He increased the civil rights of every Black person in the United States, and affected every facet of life for us all. Many things came from his work, from the death of segregation to the Voting Rights Act, to the first Black president, even leading to the prevalence of interracial couples on TV. Many Jews helped in this fight. We are inextricably linked. My friend Chuck Sachs is coming on the 16th, to play piano during the service. We will celebrate Martin Luther King Jr's life in song.

At the end of the month, on the 30th, we read about the crossing of the sea. It is a very unique page in Torah, one unlike any other. I will be chanting the Song of the Sea. It is also Shabbat Shirah, the Sabbath of Song, a very important day for cantors especially. Many cantors present musical guests and do special music for this service. Stay tuned.

I wish you love, and may your light and joy increase, as the days get longer.
