From the Rabbi's Desk Yom Huledet Sameach Temple Beth Sholom!

Sixty-five years ago, in 1950, the population of the United States reached over 150 million people and New York was its most populous state. The Korean War began that April; in February 1950 Senator Joe McCarthy claimed he had a list of 205 people in the State Department who were known members of the American Communist Party, and so began "McCarthyism;" era of gasoline was 18 cents a gallon; Cinderella and Sunset Blvd were playing in the movie theaters; the first credit card (Diner's Club) was issued; and Temple Beth Sholom of Flushing was founded.

A lot has changed in sixty-five years, but Temple Beth Sholom is still here and going strong. Last month. celebrated we Confirmation of Emily Costa, Joseph Gandelman and Adison Lemmon, our newest members of the TBS community as they led us in prayer and demonstrated their commitment to Judaism. They spoke about Tikkun Olam and the importance of making our world a better place. They are the next generation and our future. We should be so proud of them.

We also have strong roots. I

was fortunate to have recently conducted a memorial service for one of our founding members, Phyllis Fischer Margolin. Although her husband, Harold Fischer passed away in 1969 and the family moved to Long Island over fifty years ago, they had such fond memories of Temple Beth Sholom that they wanted to hold the service here at Temple Beth Sholom. We were able to accommodate them and they were so appreciative.

This month we will celebrate Temple Sholom's Beth Birthday and also honor Bernice Berman and Roger Opstbaum for their many years of dedication to Temple Beth Sholom. Please join us on June 13 at 10 am for Shabbat morning services and a Kiddush luncheon. That day is also an anniversary for me of sorts, as I became a Bat Mitzvah on that Shabbat - Shelach-lecha. Forty-one years ago, I never would have dreamed of becoming a rabbi, but I remember that in my D'var Torah, I spoke about the importance of Judaism and its survival.

In order for our synagogue to survive another sixty-five years we need to continue to engage and educate our children about the importance of Judaism. We have a wonderful Religious school that is doing just that. As always we are fortunate that our Temple arms—Parents' Association, Sisterhood and Men's Club continue to keep Temple Beth Sholom a vibrant community.
