# June Board of Trustees Meeting

The Board of Trustees met on Monday, June 15, 2015. The Board passed the May Financial Report as presented by Treasurer Mike Temares. Financial Secretary Joyce Moss reported our current number of membership units is 133. Sisterhood President Barbara Gandelman reported that Sisterhood donated \$3,000.00 to Temple, and that Rummage earned \$2,700.00. Men's Club Co-President Eric Bernstein reported Men's Club donated \$1,000.00 to Temple. The Board approved the allocation of funds to the Membership Committee to pursue outreach advertising postcards in the Western Queens area. After a discussion on the recent closure of the Bayside Jewish Center as well as difficulties encountered by many long-time members of Free Synagogue of Flushing, the Board voted unanimously to extend the option to any members of either Temple who had made a financial commitment to their respective synagogues that they can join us without additional charge through this current fiscal year, including High Holiday Services. Jim Kettig reported on bids and the scope of work to repair the roof and the Board approved allocation of funds to make necessary repairs. Rabbi Sharon Ballan requested that a committee be formed to discuss what we want to do for Adult Education. Past President Dr. Roger Opstbaum thanked all who "put up with [him] all these years" and observed that Temple is highly spirited and cooperative and that he leaves at a time when the Pulpit and the Leadership is in "good hands".
